Prof. Pawan Sudhir welcomed the DAB members and after a quick round of introduction, shared the action taken report of the Department on the DAB minutes of 2014-15. The minutes were approved by the members.

Dr. Jyotsna Tiwari, Associate Professor, DEAA revisited the report of previous year (2014-15). While explaining about Art Integrated learning she emphasized on the extensive work done under the programme all over the country in the past year and stated that under this programme this year six other states are proposed to be added.

Explaining about the programme "Teacher's handbook in Music, Dance & Theatre" Dr. Sharbari Banerjee, Assistant Prof. DEAA informed the house about the collaboration with Doordarshan archives (Prasar Bharti). She also emphasized on introducing some new trends in Music and Theatre education in Schools. There was a discussion on the celebration of International Arts Education week and its impact on pre-service and in – service teachers and teacher educators in DIETs and SCERTs.

Prof. Pawan Sudhir took the opportunity to explain about Kala Utsav which was going to be held in December 2015. She discussed the agenda, guidelines, issues regarding advocacy of living tradition of Arts and promotion of Arts Education in all States. The important issue regarding participation of differently abled (Implementation of inclusive education) was also complemented by all members. Referring to Kala Utsav as a grand event all the participants congratulated the efforts of DEAA. Vishal C. Bhand, Associate Professor, Vishwabharti, Shantiniketan, who was present as an External Member, suggested to promote art as a skill based education. While talking about Kala Utsav he emphasized organization of National Kala Utsav every year. He also suggested that the programme should be celebrated in other cities also.

Dr. Tiwari discussed the proposed programmes for the coming academic year 2016-17. She informed that in the next financial year three new academic programmes will be introduced and three ongoing programmes will be conducted. Different suggestions were made by the members and nominees for the programme ' Translation of the 'Training Package on Arts Education for Primary Teachers' in Hindi. The Programme Co-ordinator Prof. Pawan Sudhir explained the demand of the training package in Hindi. Prof. Chandra Sadayat also suggested translating the package in different regional languages so that the package benefits a bigger population.

The next programme discussed was the ongoing programme in the next academic year "Online course on Art appreciation". Dr. Jyotsna Tiwari gave an overall outlook of the programme and discussed how this programme would academically sensitize the teachers and students of secondary education. Rajesh K. Nimesh and suggested change in the language in the objectives of the programme.

Prof. Pawan Sudhir stated that this year "Capacity building programme for master trainers on Art integrated learning" will be extended to Gujarat, Maharashtra, Laskhwadeep, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh and Andaman & Nicobar Island.

While discussing about the programme 'Continuous In service Teachers' Professional development programme for secondary teachers of art education' Dr. Tiwari explained that the objective of the programme is to enhance the quality of learning among secondary students with specific objectives like

- Update and introduce teachers on different issues and concerns of the NCF2005
- Refresh their knowledge and skill of the art form and bring it into practice.
