

## **I. MINUTES OF DEPARTMENTAL ADVISORY BOARD (DAB) 2018-19**

### **Department of Education in Arts and Aesthetics (DEAA)**

The meeting of the Departmental Advisory Board (DAB) of DEAA was held on December 20, 2017 in the Department at G.B Pant Block, NIE, New Delhi to discuss progress of the on- going PAC approved programmes of 2017-18 and the programmes proposed for the year 2018-19.

Prof. Jyotsna Tiwari welcomed the DAB members and after a round of formal introduction, the action taken report on the DAB minutes of 2017-18 of the Department was presented. Report of the PAC programmes of 2017-18 was shared with members in detail by the concerned faculty members coordinating those programmes. Progress of the program in brief is as follows;

#### **23.01 A Study to Assess the Competency Level of Music Teachers (Vocal & Instrumental) At the Upper Primary and Secondary Stage (VI – X)**

The research programme taken up by the department “A Study to Assess the Competency Level of Music Teachers (Vocal & Instrumental) at the Upper Primary and Secondary Stage (VI – X)” Dr. Sharbari Banerjee briefed about the steps taken and progress of the programme. She also summarized about the evaluation tools used for the research work as well as procedure followed for the completion of the programme.

#### **23.02 Development of E-content in Music for class XI**

It was discussed in the meeting that E-content material has been developed according to the content mapping done based on the syllabus developed by NCERT after NCF-2005.

#### **23.03 Translation of the ‘Training Package on Arts Education for Primary Teachers’ in Hindi and Urdu**

Prof. Pawan Sudhir, Coordinator, of the program, informed the house that the work related to the Hindi translation of the Volume 1 & II of the ‘Training Package on Arts Education for primary teachers is completed and submitted to the Publication Division for further necessary action. However she further elaborated on the workshop to develop subtitles of the video films and slide shows (which is a part of the package) in

Hindi will be done in February 2018. It is an ongoing program, the studio editing with the CIET team for Hindi version of the video films and slide shows, and making of a DVD which is an integral part of this training package will be taken up from April to June 2018. Publishing of the Training package is likely to be over by August 2018.

Regarding Urdu translation of the Training Package it was informed that Urdu translation for the Vol. I and II has been done in the workshop mode. The review and finalization workshops of five day each for the Vol. I and II are scheduled to be held in the months of December 2017 and February 2018. However editing and layout will be done in April-July 2018 and the CRC can be submitted for the publication approximately by August 2018.

#### **23.04 Online Course on Local Heritage Mapping for Schools**

For the programme, 'Online Course on Local Heritage Mapping for Schools', Prof. Jyotsna Tiwari explained that around 50 teachers have registered for the programme online. She also discussed the difficulties faced by the co-coordinator and teachers due to shifting of Courses from one platform to the other. Now the content is being re-organized according to the Swayam platform as well as ITPD platform, so that it can run smoothly.

#### **23.05 Capacity Building Programme for Master Trainers on Art Integrated Learning**

Prof. Pawan Sudhir, coordinator of the program informed the house that Capacity Building programme on Art Integrated Learning to improve the quality of learning and development at primary level has been completed. She explained that this was the second and final phase of the Capacity Building of five states; Andhra, AN Islands, Gujarat, Kerala and Maharashtra master trainers (MTs) on Art Integrated Learning. In addition to this the department has also conducted four 'school based' capacity building programs on Art Integrated Learning for the primary teachers of all four D M Schools in RIEs.

#### **23.06 Resource Centre for Arts & Crafts**

The programme 'Resource Centre for Arts & Crafts (23.06) was conducted in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of May, 2017 and around 100 children participated in it. Dr. Sarvari Banerjee explained about the program in detail. There were separate workshops with school children of different age groups in four different art forms; Music, Dance, Theatre and Visual Arts. Program was liked by all the participants.
