

Dr. Gouri Srivastava, has done her M.A., M.Phil from Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) and Ph.D. from Delhi University. As a student and as a professional she has received scholarships at the National and International level from JNU, Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR), Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) for pursuing M.Phil (1984) and Ph.D. work (1985-86). Scholarship was granted by the George Eckert Institute for International Textbook Research, Braunschweig, Germany to carry out research on analysis of social science textbooks of South Asia from the view point of Gender and Peace (2006).
