

Neeraja Rashmi

Professor Neeraja Rashmi, DESS, NCERT obtained her M.A. in Economics from Patna University with a gold medal and her Ph.D. from Magadh University. Prior to joining NCERT, she taught Economics at Manipur University, Imphal from 1985-1997. She also holds a Masters Diploma in Educational Research from Vrije Universiteit Brussels, Belgium. She joined NCERT in 1997. Her areas of research interests include Economics and Social Sciences education in schools, gender and issues related to the North-east of India.



During her tenure at NCERT, Prof. Rashmi has been involved with the development of syllabus and textbooks in Economics and Social Science during 2000 and 2005. She was also a team member in Social Science Position Paper in 2005. Prof. Rashmi has co-authored various textbooks of NCERT titled *Contemporary India, Part I* (Class IX, 2001), *Contemporary India, Part II* (Class X, 2002), *Indian Economic Development* (Class XI, 2006), *Statistics for Economics* (Class XI, 2006), *Understanding Economic Development* (Class X, 2006). She has also translated 3 textbooks of Economics from English to Hindi, *Rashtriya Aye Lekha Paddhati* (Class XII, 2000), *Sankhyiki Ka Parichay* (Class XI, 2001-02), and *Bharat Ka Arthik Vikas* (Class XI, 2001-02). She has coordinated the preparation of a number of textbooks, *Indian Economic Development*, (Class XI, 2002), *Introduction to Statistics*, (Class XI, 2002), *Introductory Microeconomics* (Class XII (2002), and *Statistics for Economics*, (Class XI, 2006). She has also developed MOOCs, e-content, and QR code in economics. She has organized many training programmes for Economics teachers of CTSA and NVS and has been a member of Course Committee in Economics at CBSE. She was also a resource-person in the areas of Social sciences and gender in NISTHA training programme during 2019-20.

Prof. Rashmi has developed a '*Trilingual Dictionary of Economics for Schools (English-Hindi-Urdu)*, NCERT, 2016', and a Supplementary Reader titled '*North-East India: People, History and Culture*, NCERT, 2017' in three versions of English, Hindi and Urdu. She has authored a book, *Women of North East India: Making a Difference*, NCERT, 2018. She has also scripted and guided a film on Manipur in 2 parts on the history, religion, culture and sports, in collaboration with CIET in 2017-18. She also contributed in *Introducing India in Korean Textbooks: A Module on India* (2020). She has

headed the Department of Education in Social Sciences for a term of 3-years (2014-17). At present she is engaged in the development of an *Online Course for Teachers in Social Sciences*.
